Agenda – Mayor Pampusch presented the council with two items for the agenda.

Resolution 14-09 Application for an Off-site Gambling Permit – North Suburban Youth Foundation, on behalf of Moose Country, has submitted an application to conduct off-site gambling in the form of a raffle on September 27, 2014, for the Officer Scott Patrick Family Benefit. Moose Country owner Joe Schaefer told the council that the raffle ticket will not be tax deductible; however, those making a donation to the Officer Scott Patrick Family will receive a receipt and it will be a tax deductible contribution. **Motion by Councilmember Peterson, seconded by Councilmember Lundberg to approve the application from North Suburban Youth Foundation to conduct Off-Site Gambling in the form of a raffle at 857 Sibley Memorial Hwy., Lilydale, MN. Passed 4-0.**

Business License Application for T.H.A.T. Cooking School – Alex Niemer, owner of T.H.A.T. Cooking School, asked the council to consider his business license so he can open on September 27th for the Officer Scott Patrick Fundraiser. T.H.A.T. Cooking School will be located in the space formerly occupied by the Chef's Abode in the River Bluffs Center. **Motion by Councilmember Bullard, seconded by Councilmember Lundberg to approve a business license for T.H.A.T. Cooking School. Passed 4-0.**
