

LILYDALE CITY COUNCIL SPECIAL MEETING
January 30, 2023

Present – Mayor John Diehl, Councilmembers Lyle Hanzal and Bill Kleinman; Mary Schultz, City Clerk; Bridget Nason, attorney

Absent – Councilmembers Cornell and Kleinberg

Call to Order – Mayor Diehl called the meeting to order at 9:18 a.m.

Code Book Update – Chapters 10. Waste Abatement and 4. Water and Sewer were reviewed and discussed paragraph by paragraph.

There was consensus for the following amendments to Chapter 10: 1) add language to encourage recycling at large events; 2) change hours and days of collection to 6 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday through Friday, and on Saturdays due to special circumstances such as holidays and poor weather conditions; 3) add a section stating commercial generators are required to follow the County ordinance.

The position of water/sewer commissioner was discussed. This position has not been filled for many years. Attorney Nason will check to see how this is handled in the City of Sunfish Lake.

Section 401.02 – Clerk Schultz will ask building official Mike Andrejka about the role and responsibility of the building official in inspecting a building sewer connection.

Section 402.01, subd. 4 - Attorney Nason will research the definition of “available” in reference to the requirement to connect to the public sewer system if it is within 200 feet of the structure generating the wastewater.

Recess - Mayor Diehl recessed the meeting and called an emergency meeting at 11:27 a.m.

Reconvene and Continue - Moved by Councilmember Diehl and seconded by Councilmember Kleinman to continue the special meeting to February 3, 2023 at 10:00 a.m. Motion carried 3-0. The meeting recessed at 12:20 p.m.
