

LILYDALE CITY COUNCIL SPECIAL MEETING
July 27, 2023

Present: Mayor John Diehl and Councilmembers Deborah Cornell, Lyle Hanzal, Mary Kleinberg and Bill Kleinman; Mary Schultz, city clerk and Bridget Nason, attorney

Call to Order – Mayor Diehl called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

Mayor Diehl noted the purpose of the meeting is to review changes to the code of ordinances.

Chapters 1-3 have been adopted.

Review Code Book Updates – Chapters 4-8 and 10 were reviewed and discussed in depth. Numerous changes were made throughout the chapters. Notable items included the following.

In chapter 4 the parts on water and sewer utilities are missing and will be added back in. Attorney Nason will check with city engineer Jen Koehler on several items including dewatering, reference to emergency dispatch services, the process for stormwater management plan approval, and notice of construction commencement.

After discussion regarding the new adult cannabis law the city council requested Attorney Nason prepare a moratorium for the August 14th city council meeting.

A section on peddlers and transient merchants will be added back in to chapter 5 to reflect that registration will be required, but a license will not.

Clerk Schultz sent chapter 6 Traffic and Motor Vehicles to Captain Wegener for review.

Section 802.10 Fires or Barbecues on Balconies or Patios will not change from the existing code.

Due to the late hour, Mayor Diehl asked councilmembers to review chapter 8 further and send any suggested revisions to Clerk Schultz who will then forward them to Attorney Nason for incorporation into the draft ordinance.

The council agreed to hold a special meeting on August 14th at 3:00 p.m. to review updated drafts of chapters 5 and 8. Chapters 4-8 and 10 will be presented for adoption at the regular meeting on August 14th.
