Resolution 2020-17 Canvassing the 2020 Municipal General Election Results – The council reviewed the Abstract of Votes Cast in the Precincts of the City of Lilydale at the State General election held on November 3, 2020 as shown on Exhibit A of Resolution 2020-17. The number of person registered as of 7 a.m. on November 3, 2020 was 809. The number of persons voting on November 3rd was 769.
