

LILYDALE CITY COUNCIL SPECIAL MEETING
December 21, 2022

Call to Order - Acting Mayor Diehl called the meeting to order at 10:35 a.m.

Code Book Update – Proposed revisions to Chapters 1, 2, and 3 were reviewed and discussed. Attorney will make the changes as noted and prepare updated documents for further review. Attorney Nason left the meeting at 1:45 p.m.

The following changes to Chapter 3, part 5 were suggested:

- Include an acknowledgement that all parks in the city are managed by other entities.
- Section 305.03, subd. 12. Bicycles should be moved to a different section and revised to prohibit them from pedestrian paths.
- Section 305.03, subd. 7. Fireworks should be moved to a different section.
- A subdivision regulating the use of drones due to the city’s geographical location in relation to airspace should be added to the Code, possibly Chapter 5, Zoning.

A city council special meeting to continue work on the Code Book starting with Chapter 5 was tentatively scheduled for January 10, 2023 at 9 a.m.

Clerk Schultz will share the above changes to Chapter 5 with Attorney Nason, and find out her availability for January 10th.

Adjournment – Moved by Councilmember Hanzal and seconded by Councilmember Cornell to adjourn. Motion carried 4-0. The meeting adjourned at 2:32 p.m.
